#### DAY 1 | TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 24 FLIGHT TO HONOLULU (OAHU)


Depart for a Hawaiian adventure. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the evening is at your leisure.
