#### DAY1 | SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 22 FLIGHT TO DUBLIN, IRELAND

Depart on an overnight flight to Dublin to start our Ireland and Scotland adventure.

#### DAY 2 | MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23 DUBLIN, IRELAND

Welcome to Dublin!

Explore Dublin starting with visits to St. Patrick's Cathedral and Trinity College (Book of Kells).

A stunning stalwart of medieval Dublin, **ST. PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL** offers a rich cultural experience with its 800-year history.

The largest cathedral in the country and onetime post of Jonathan Swift, author of Gulliver's Travel, St. Patrick's Cathedral is a stunning work of gothic architecture, with its Lady Chapel, dating from 1270, recently being restored to its original glory. Be sure to explore the building, stopping into the Lives Remembered exhibition and its specially commissioned tree sculpture in memory of World War 1. A true highlight is its choir, which performs during school terms and in the Lady Chapel.

An exquisite combination of intricate illuminations and Latin text, the Book of Kells is housed in the magic-tinged library in **TRINITY COLLEGE**, Dublin.

A 9th-century masterpiece, the **BOOK OF KELLS** is a unique insight into a rich part of Ireland's culture for bibliophiles and non-bibliophiles alike. Learn how the famous medieval manuscript was created, explore a spectacular library home to more than 200,000 texts, and come to understand an ornate part of history.

#### DAY 3 | TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24 DUBLIN, IRELAND

Relax into a hidden horticultural gem in **POWERSCOURT ESTATE**, a long-standing heritage property with winding walks, beautiful gardens, and glorious flora.

Unravel historical treasures with a global flair, including gates from Venice, statues from Rome, and antiquated Irish allure in Avoca, a charming terrace café.

Perfect for leisurely walks or lengthy exploration, Powerscourt Estate and Gardens brings nature to life.

Around the world, Ireland is known for its Guinness, its famous dry stout. No trip to Ireland is complete without a visit to the **GUINNESS STOREHOUSE**, an interactive multi-story sensory extravaganza in the heart of the city center at St James Gate Brewery.

With a 250-year history, you'll be taken through the intricate architecture of the seven-story building, discover age-old secrets of Guinness, visit the tasting rooms, and learn to pour the perfect pint.

Complete your visit with the symbolic "Head of the Pint," at the Gravity Bar, a top-floor bar with breath-taking panoramic views of Dublin city.

### DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25 DUBLIN TO KILLARNEY, IRELAND

Visit the old fortress on the **ROCK OF CASHEL**. This limestone rock, crowned with secular and religious buildings, dominates the countryside.



St. Patrick, Ireland's patron saint, baptized King Aengus here in the 5th century.

Visit **BLARNEY CASTLE**, built nearly six hundred years ago by one of Ireland's greatest chieftains. Legend tells us that the Blarney stone situated on the grounds of Blarney Castle imparts the gift of eloquence to those who kiss it.

This evening enjoy dinner at your hotel.

#### DAY 5 | THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 26 KILLARNEY, IRELAND

Today travel the road that winds around the beautiful Iveragh Peninsula, better known as "**THE RING OF KERRY**." It is undoubtedly one of the most magical places in all Ireland. Here mountains, valleys, lakes and sea blend into a landscape that is often breathtaking beyond words.

Join a local specialist for a scenic guided walk at Torc Waterfall, strolling over wooded paths and lakeshore trails. Hear stories of the surroundings and learn about the flora and fauna, while finishing your hike at the magnificent Muckross Estate & Gardens.

Take a step back in time to the 1930s and '40s, with a visit to **MUCKROSS FARM** in the picturesque village of Killarney, Kerry. 1930' s Ireland was a very different place with no electricity or the easy luxuries of modern life. Live like the Irish did in days gone by as you visit three separate working farms which are furnished in traditional style, including settlebeds and mealbins, and then call into the laborer's cottage, a carpenter's workshop, and a blacksmith's forge. Your last stop is the schoolhouse where students footed turf for open fires.

### DAY 6 | FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 27 KILLARNEY TO GALWAY, IRELAND

Cross the Shannon Estuary by ferry.

A natural masterpiece, the **CLIFFS OF MOHER** are a must-see for any trip to Ireland. Set against the crashing waves of the Atlantic Ocean, the Cliffs tower a striking distance above the sea. Named a UNESCO Global Geopark, the Cliffs are best experienced on a walk or trek across the clifftop. Watch birds, study plants, and keep an eye on the water for breaks of dolphin pods or sharks. Come to know the myths and magic of the Cliffs of Moher with sights including the Tower viewpoint, the Aran Islands, and the Hags Head.

### DAY 7 | SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28 ASHFORD CASTLE

Enjoy a leisurely cruise on **LOUGH CORRIB**, the largest lake in the Republic of Ireland. The River Corrib connects this lake to the sea at Galway, and Ashford Castle is nestled right on the lake shore. This cruise includes a stop and guided tour on the historic island of Inchagoill.

This evening enjoy dinner at Cullen's at the Cottage.

### DAY 9 | MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 30 BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND

Take an extraordinary journey into the past with the **TITANIC BELFAST MUSEUM**, an ode to one of the most famous tragedies of our time.

Set across an iconic six-floor building with nine interactive galleries, you'll experience the Titanic through a miasma of stories, sights, and sounds.

Traverse the recently restored SS Nomadic, one of the Titanic's service boats, see artifacts from the ship itself, walk the decks, explore the shipyard, and comb through film director James Cameron's redeveloped galleries of the ship's launch day and maiden, ill-fated voyage in the city where it all began.

#### DAY 10 | TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1 BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND

Both the legendary handiwork of giant Finn McCool and an impressive rock structure forged from fire, the **GIANT'S CAUSEWAY** is a dramatic basalt structure which has inspired writers and artists the world over. A focal point as a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, learn about the history of the Giant's Causeway in the state-of-the-art visitor center. Enjoy stories of science and legend in the exhibition.

Meet a local specialist for a living history tour which takes you through the landmarks that have played their part in Belfast's colorful development. During the course of the tour, you will see many well-known features of the city including City Hall, Queens University, Ulster Museum, Botanic Gardens and Albert Clock.

Gather with your fellow Mayo Clinic travelers for a farewell drink this evening before heading out to dinner at your leisure.



#### DAY 12 | THURSDAY, OCTOBER 3 EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND

Explore the city of Edinburgh beyond the reach of tour buses and guidebooks. Your expert guide will take you to the places where history was made. The characters? Think Mary Queen of Scots, David Hume, Adam Smith and Robert Burns. But you'll go far beyond the well-known facts and faces uncovering another side of the city, and Scotland's past. Discover the true stories of the capital's past, from crime and culture to politics and everyday events. Continue on to **EDINBURGH CASTLE**, dominating Scotland's capital city from its great rock. Battles and sieges were fought over it, royalty lived and died within its walls, and countless generations have been inspired by it. Visit the castle with your guide who will walk straight over the drawbridge, and straight past the ticket line to continue your history tour with a guided visit.

Open throughout the year, **HOLYROOD PALACE** is the official Edinburgh residence of the Queen and year-round home of Scottish royal history.

Standing at the end of Edinburgh's historic, picturesque Royal Mile, discover the Palace's ties with notable figures from history, including Mary Queen of Scots and the Bonnie Prince Charlie.



Explore 14 spectacular State Apartments, the ruins of the 12th-century Holyrood Abbey, and the sprawling splendor of the royal gardens.

#### DAY 13 | FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4 EDINBURGH TO INVERNESS, SCOTLAND

**ST ANDREWS** is known as the home of golf and is also home to one of the world's oldest universities.

Set amongst the magnificent scenery of Royal Deeside, in the shadows of Lochnagar is the **BALMORAL ESTATE**. Purchased by Queen Victoria in 1848, the Estate has been the Scottish Home of the British Royal Family ever since.

## DAY 14 | SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5 INVERNESS, SCOTLAND

Breakfast is included at the hotel.

According to legend, **CAWDOR CASTLE** was built around a thorn tree that dates back to 1372. Catch a glimpse of the ancient tree from the depths of the castle's dungeons. With strong connections to Shakespeare's Macbeth, Cawdor Castle is a sumptuous treat for history buffs. A fourstory tower- house, the Keep is still home to the Cawdor family, and is impeccably furnished with a sprawling Tapestry Bedroom, a fine Dining Room, and 19th-century kitchen. Be sure to walk the beautiful garden grounds and the Cawdor Big Wood, with paths to suit every activity level.

In 1746, two armies gathered in a vicious battle that would leave 1,600 men dead. It was the final battle of the Jacobite Rising, where the Duke of Cumberland's government troops fought Jacobite supporters on **CULLODEN BATTLEFIELDS**.



Now, more than 300 years later, the true story of the epic, last great battle on British soil is brought to life at the Culloden Visitor Center in interactive displays, an enthralling collection of curios and artifacts, a 360-degree battle immersion theatre, and a bracing visit to the memorial cairn, where the fallen Jacobite soldiers are buried.

#### DAY 15 | SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6 SCOTTISH HIGHLANDS

Travel through **GLENCOE**, one of Scotland's most famous and most scenic Highland glens.

One of the last remaining wildernesses in Europe, the **GREAT MOOR OF RANNOCH** is a beautiful outdoor space stretching far north and west from Rannoch Station. There's no better way to experience **LOCH LOMOND**'s network islands and curious history than via the comfort of a cruise. Relax with a drink from the fully stocked bar as the Experience Cruise on Loch Lomond takes you on a stunning onehour tour of the Loch's south basin with its views of the towering Ben Lomond, stately homes, and castles. Cross the Loch to Inchmurrin Island, and revel in the splendor of the ancient ruins of Lennox Castle, which sheltered then-fugitive Robert the Bruce before he became King of Scotland.
