DAY 1 | TUESDAY, JUNE 16, 2026 INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT TO JAPAN

Built in the 16th century by Toyotomi Mideyoshi, the warlord who then controlled Japan, Osaka Castle offers extensive displays of weapons, armor, and folk life relics of that era. The ancient Sumiyoshi Taisha Shrine and its sanctuaries are designated national treasures.

Stroll through the Dotonbori district, a must-see for visitors to Osaka. Here you can experience the city's well-known reputation as a foodie's paradise.



The streets are crowded with restaurants, bars, and street-side food stalls that serve everything from kebabs and crabs to fugu and shabu shabu. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 | MONDAY, JUNE 22, 2026 KYOTO (OSAKA), JAPAN

Depart: 6:00 pm

A second day in Osaka means even more time to discover both ancient and modern Japanese history and culture. Visit Osaka Aquarium, one of the world's largest aquariums which has over 580 species of sea life on display, or Universal Studios Japan, the company's first theme park outside of the U.S. Kyoto served as the nation's capital for more than 1,000 years and is home to 17 different World Heritage Sites including Kiyomizudera Temple and Heian Jingu Shrine. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 | TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2026 KOCHI, JAPAN

Docked: 8:00 am-5:00 pm

The capital of Kochi Prefecture on the southern coast of Shikoku is small, friendly, and boasts several attractions of interest to travelers. Make sure to enjoy some Katsuo no tataki, Kochi's most famous dish, and visit the temple and botanical garden at Mount Godaisan. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 | WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24, 2026 DAY AT SEA

While at sea, take the time to recharge before the next adventure. Lounge by the pool, be spoiled at the spa, taste the delicacies or explore the venues on-board, until we arrive at the next amazing destination. (B, L, D)



DAY 10 | THURSDAY, JUNE 25, 2026 BUSAN, SOUTH KOREA

It is Busan's premier trading port, adjacent to the Korean Straits and Japan, that makes it an international metropolis but its beautiful sea vistas that make it a charming place to unwind. Docked: 8:00 am-7:00 pm

Historically rich Nagasaki features beautiful seaside scenery and fabulous nighttime views from its mountain slopes. Secluded hot springs, fascinating museums, and ornate temples live side by side in this exciting city. Ten natural parks grace the area, and unique festivals can be experienced throughout the year. Walk through streets influenced by both Chinese and European cultures in fascinating Nagasaki. (B, L, D)

DAY 12 SATURDAY, JUNE 27, 2026 KAGOSHIMA, JAPAN

Docked: 7:00 am-5:00 pm

Kagoshima is the southernmost city on Japan's bullet train network and the capital of Kagoshima Prefecture. The city is often compared with its Italian sister city, Naples, due to a similarly mild climate, streets lined with palm trees, and Sakurajima, Kagoshima's version of Vesuvius. Near port, find the fascinating Kagoshima aquarium, traditional Senganen Japanese gardens, museums, the Shiroyama mountain-top park with a view over the city,



and Yakushima Island, a registered world heritage site. Plus, an abundance of hot springs, mud baths, and spas to promote serenity and relaxation. (B, L, D)

DAY 13 | SUNDAY, JUNE 28, 2026 DAY AT SEA

Relax, recharge, and spend time reminiscing on the last two weeks of adventure with friends old and new. (B, L, D)

DAY 14 | MONDAY, JUNE 29, 2026 MT. FUJI (SHIMIZU), JAPAN

On clear days Mount Fuji (Fuji-san in Japanese) is visible from as far as Tokyo, 60 miles away. When Japan's highest mountain is capped with snow, it's a picture-postcard perfect volcanic cone.
