DAY 1 | SATURDAY, JUNE 14 FLIGHT TO MUNICH, GERMANY

Depart on an overnight international flight to Munich, Germany to start our European adventure.

DAY 2 | SUNDAY, JUNE 15 MUNICH, GERMANY

Welcome to Munich! Spend the day discovering the capital of Bavaria and one of Germany's largest cities, as well as the undisputed beer capital of the world.

DAY 3 | MONDAY, JUNE 16 EMBARK: VILSHOFEN, GERMANY

Breakfast is included at the hotel.

Enjoy a morning guided sightseeing tour of

Munich before departing to Vilshofen.

Board the *AmaBella* for your Romantic Danube cruise. Later in the day, attend an exclusive Oktoberfest celebration with traditional beer and Bavarian folk music and dancing. (B, D)

DAY 4 | TUESDAY, JUNE 17 VILSHOFEN + PASSAU, GERMANY

Explore Vilshofen's beautiful old town before cruising to Passau, known as the "City of Three Rivers." Join a walking tour or if you prefer to be more active, hike high into the hills for a visit to the "Veste Oberhaus," Passau's Castle Hill; or go on a River Inn bike tour. (B, L, D)

DAY 5 | WEDNESDAY, JUNE 18 LINZ, AUSTRIA

The ship arrives in Linz where you'll have several choices of excursions. Opt for a full-day excursion to Salzburg where you'll tour the historic center, Mirabell Gardens, Residenz Square and the Old Market.



En route to Salzburg, stop at Mondsee, home of the famed Basilica St. Michael and site of the wedding scene in The Sound of Music.

You may also choose to join a full-day excursion to the charming Czech mountain town of Český Krumlov, where you can stroll its cobblestone streets; marvel at the city's picturesque Baroque and Renaissance-style buildings; and tour Krumlov Castle, one of Europe's largest castle complexes.

Following these full-day excursions, you may also choose to take a brief walking tour in Linz. Alternatively, join a walking tour through the old city center of Linz and by the Mozart House; or bike along the city's famed "Cultural Mile" and the Danube. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 | THURSDAY, JUNE 19 WEISSENKIRCHEN, AUSTRIA

Cruise through the Strudengau and Wachau valleys to Weissenkirchen, gateway to Dürnstein. Once here, you can choose to join a walking tour

in Dürnstein along its cobblestone streets to the Baroque Stiftskirche, and then visit Melk's magnificent Benedictine Abbey. For the more active adventurer, you can opt to hike up to the fortress where Richard the Lionheart was once held, or take a bike ride along the Danube through the Wachau Valley. As an alternative excursion, visit a local apricot grower, where you'll enjoy the region's finest apricot treats. Later in the evening, enjoy a special wine tasting of locally grown, world-renowned Riesling and Grüner Veltliner in Weissenkirchen. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 | FRIDAY, JUNE 20 VIENNA, AUSTRIA

The "City of Waltzes" offers a treasure trove of gems and your city tour showcases them, including the majestic Opera House and the former Imperial Palace. Your tour concludes in the historic city center with a visit to St. Stephen's Cathedral. Or if you prefer a more active tour, take a guided bike ride through Vienna.



During the afternoon, enjoy leisure time to further explore this iconic city. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 | SATURDAY, JUNE 21 BRATISLAVA, SLOVAKIA

Host to the crowning ceremonies of 11 Hungarian kings and queens between 1536 and 1830, Bratislava certainly has earned the title "Coronation City of Kings," as you'll discover during your walking tour. Or join a special "Tastes of Slovakia" tour. For a more active adventure, hike up to Bratislava Castle, offering magnificent views of the city. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 | SUNDAY, JUNE 22 BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

Today you have the opportunity to visit both the Buda (hilly) and Pest (flat) sides of the Danube River. Start on the Buda side, following your guide through the city's Castle District where you will marvel at the fairytale turrets of Fisherman's Bastion, gaze upon the breathtaking panorama

below and see Matthias Church, renowned for its striking tower and colorful mosaic roof. For a more active tour, hike to Budapest's Castle Hill. In the afternoon, explore the treasures of Pest, admiring the colossal Hungarian Parliament Building, Heroes' Square and the moving "Shoes on the Danube Bank" memorial. (B,L,D)

DAY 10 | MONDAY, JUNE 23 DISEMBARK: BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

Disembark the ship in Budapest and enjoy a morning guided sightseeing tour on our final day of exploration. The remainder of the day and evening are at your leisure. (B)

DAY II | TUESDAY, JUNE 24 RETURN TO US

Breakfast is included at the hotel.

You'll be transferred to Budapest's airport for our return flight home. (B)



Elevator does not reach the Sun Deck or Piano Deck




