

## DAY 1 WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9 OVERNIGHT FLIGHT

Then, board the two-hour AVE high-speed train to Spain's capital city, Madrid! Arrive in the late afternoon and enjoy an evening at leisure to explore as you wish.
