

#### **DAY 1 // FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2026 DEPART HOME**

Depart from your home city on your overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

#### DAY 2 // SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2026 **ARRIVE IN LISBON, PORTUGAL**

Upon your arrival in Lisbon, you will meet your AmaWaterways representatives who will greet you and assist you to your transfers to your hotel. The remainder of your day is free.

#### **DAY 3 // SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2026 LISBON, PORTUGAL**

After breakfast at your hotel, depart for a Lisbon city tour. Visit the iconic Belém Tower, sometimes referred to as the Tower of St. Vincent. Built in 1515 it was the first and last glimpse many sailors had of Lisbon before departing for (or arriving from) the New World. You will also taste a typical Portuguese pastry, Pastéis de Belém, a sweet treat made with egg, milk, sugar and puff pastry, with a history connected to the nearby monastery. Next you will visit the Jerónimos Monastery, built in 1515, and a prominent example of the Portuguese Late Gothic Manueline architectural style. Across from the Jerónimos Monastery, the Discoveries Monument is a more recent addition, built in 1960. Another icon of discovery, the monument commemorates notable explorers such as Ferdinand Magellan and Pedro Alvares Cabral. After your tour, return to your hotel where the remainder of your day is free. (B)

#### **DAY 4 // MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2026** SINTRA, PORTUGAL

Enjoy breakfast before departing for an excursion to Sintra. Know as Serra de Sintra, it is one of the loveliest mountain villages in Portugal and a favorite summer residence of the Portuguese royal family for more than 500 years. Long an inspiration for artists and poets, Lord Byron called it "perhaps the most delightful village in Europe." High up on a rocky peak you will tour Pena Palace, a wonderful fairytale-like castle dating back to Portugal's Romantic period. Return to Lisbon where the remainder of your day is free. (B)

#### DAY 5 // TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2026 **LISBON + PORTO, PORTUGAL**

This morning you will be departing from Lisbon after breakfast. Enroute to Porto you will visit Tomar where you will take in the Castle and Convent of the Order of Christ – a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a brilliant work of 12th to 16th-century architecture. Continue onward and arrive in Porto. On arrival, board the AmaDouro ship for your river cruise. (B, D)

#### DAY 6 // WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2026 **REGUA, PORTUGAL**

This tranquil village offers an authentic slice of Douro River life. Today, visit the Baroque-style Palacio de Mateus and its gardens. Inside the house, you'll see interesting furnishings, paintings and a ceiling of intricately carved wood. The gardens here are considered some of the most beautiful in Portugal. (B, L, D)



#### DAY 7 // THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2026 **VEGA DE TERRON, SPAIN**

In the morning, spend time soaking up the beauty of this picturesque port before you visit Castelo Rodrigo, a small fortified village perched high on a hilltop with centuries-old walls, steep narrow streets and fantastic views. You can also opt to hike up to the village should you wish a more active exploration. (B, L, D)

#### **DAY 8 // FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2026 VEGA DE TERRON, SPAIN + SALAMANCA, SPAIN**

Drive to Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built of golden sandstone, Salamanca is known as a living museum, and you will have an opportunity to step back in time to the Middle Ages during your escorted tour, which includes the city's elegant university buildings, the New Cathedral, the intriguingly decorated House of Shells and Plaza Mayor. (B, L, D)

#### DAY 9 // SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2026 PINHÃO, PORTUGAL

Spend time soaking up the beauty of the Douro River as you cruise to Pinhão. Here, you may visit a local vineyard for a port wine tasting. Join a specialist from the vineyard on a private tour of the wine cellars, an exclusive opportunity to learn about centuries-old winemaking methods and to taste the vineyard's specialty wines. Afterwards, be treated to an exclusive dinner at Quinta da Roêda. Nestled in the heart of the Douro Valley, this historic estate is celebrated for its centuries-old vineyards and iconic terraced landscapes. (B, L, D)

#### **DAY 10 // SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 22, 2026 REGUA, PORTUGAL**

Travel to picturesque Lamego, home to one of the most important pilgrimage sites in all of Portugal, where you'll go to the Nossa Senhora dos Remédios (Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies). The shrine features a staircase of nearly 700 steps, beautifully decorated with white and blue tiles, which the more active adventurer will want to climb on a guided hike. Concluding both tours, you will have the opportunity to sample local traditional specialties, such as bôlas de Lamego, bread filled with smoked ham; presunto, a type of dry-cured ham; and Espumante, a Portuguese sparkling wine. Afterwards, head to a local quinta for a delicious lunch. (B, L, D)

#### **DAY 11 // MONDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 2026 PORTO, PORTUGAL**

The colorful city of Porto blends the best of old and new, which you can discover on an escorted tour of the historic quarter. This UNESCO World Heritage Site includes the Cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments; and the São Bento Railway Station, known for its blue and white tile panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history. If you prefer to get more active, you can go on a guided hike. In the afternoon, you'll also enjoy a tasting of Port, Portugal's most renowned contribution to the world of wine. When the sun sets, enjoy the illuminated landscapes of Porto on a scenic cruise aboard your ship. (B, L, D)


#### **DAY 12 // TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2026 PORTO, PORTUGAL**


