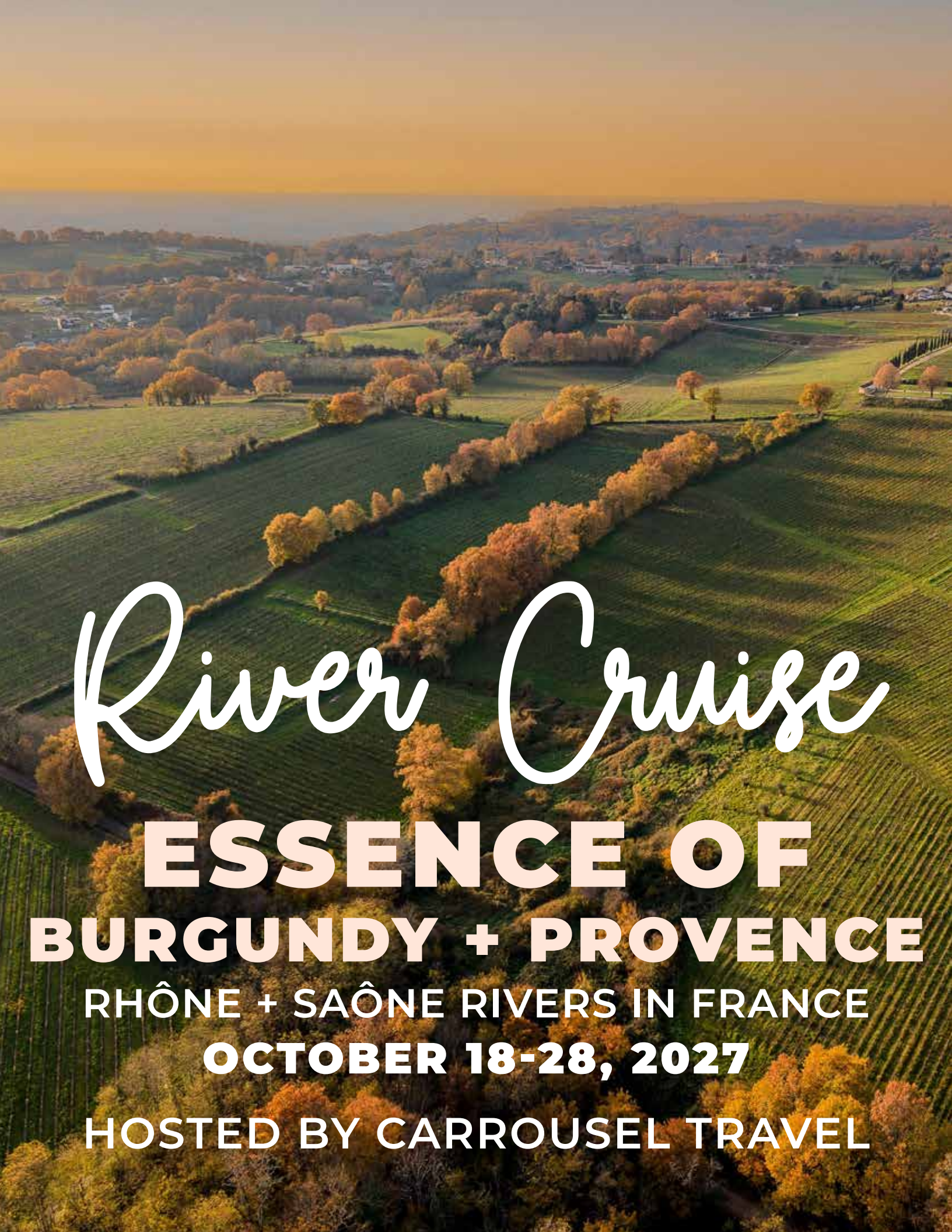

This trip includes a 2-night stay in Marseille, complete with a full-day city tour, followed by a 7-night River Cruise onboard the AmaWaterways *AmaCello* from Arles to the Port of Dijon, France. You will enjoy an extensive lineup of included tours throughout the cruise. In many cases, you will have a choice of excursions, so you can choose how you want to explore. No matter your preference, your days will be full of discovery and wonder.

Itinerary

DAY 1 // MONDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2027 FLIGHT TO FRANCE

Depart on your overnight flight from your home city to Marseille, France.

DAY 2 // TUESDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2027 MARSEILLE, FRANCE

Arrive in Marseille where you will be greeted by our representatives who will assist you with your luggage and transfers to your hotel. The remainder of your day and evening is free.

DAY 3 // WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 20, 2027 MARSEILLE, FRANCE

Today you will have a full day tour of this interesting city. Discover Marseille on a walking tour through its most iconic landmarks and historic districts. Begin with the majestic Notre-Dame de la Garde, offering breathtaking panoramic views over the city and the Mediterranean Sea. Continue to the vibrant Old Port, the heart of Marseille since Antiquity, where local life, fishing traditions and maritime heritage come together. Wander through the charming streets of Le Panier, the city's oldest district, renowned for its colorful facades, hidden squares, artisan workshops and rich history. This walking tour is the perfect introduction to Marseille's unique blend of culture, heritage and Mediterranean lifestyle.

After an included lunch, you will discover MUCEM, Marseille's iconic Museum of European and Mediterranean Civilizations. Housed in a striking contemporary building overlooking the sea, it features engaging exhibitions exploring the history, cultures, and heritage of the Mediterranean. Connected to Fort Saint-Jean by a scenic footbridge, the museum also offers breathtaking views of the Old Port and the coastline. Continue to the fascinating world of prehistoric art at Cosquer Cave, a remarkable replica of the original underwater cave located near Marseille. Through an

immersive experience, explore thousands of years of history and admire exceptional prehistoric paintings and engravings, offering a unique glimpse into the lives of our earliest ancestors. This evening enjoy an included group dinner at a local restaurant. (B, L, D)

DAY 4 // THURSDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2027 ARLES, FRANCE

Enjoy a free morning before checking out of your hotel and transferring to your AmaWaterways river ship in Arles, France. Board your ship and relax before your evening onboard begins. (B, D)

DAY 5 // FRIDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2027 ARLES + AVIGNON, FRANCE

Arles is considered one of the most beautiful cities in France. Let your experienced guide lead you to the top sights, including the Romanesque cathedral and Roman amphitheater. Or, if you wish to delve further into Van Gogh's Arles, join a special walking tour including a visit to the Vincent van Gogh Foundation showcasing his legacy. Alternately, you may take a guided bike tour through town. Later in the day, enjoy a walking tour in Avignon, aptly named the "City of Popes," that includes the Papal Palace and the well-preserved medieval walls surrounding the historic center of town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. For a more flavorful experience, visit three venues around Avignon to taste regional specialties including macarons, cheese and wine, and tapenades. In the evening, enjoy a short cruise to Avignon where you will see Pont d'Avignon bridge illuminated against the night sky. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 // SATURDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2027 VIVIERS, FRANCE

Viviers is a charming medieval city with picturesque 16th and 18th century monuments. For a more active adventure, pedal through this bicycle-friendly city. Alternately, you can go to the magnificent hilltop village, Grignan.



After visiting this enchanting Provençal town, go in search of the highly prized “Black Diamond” truffles with a farmer and his trustworthy canine companion. Or, go on a scenic hike and enjoy a memorable view of Viviers. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 // SUNDAY, OCTOBER 24, 2027
VIENNE + LYON, FRANCE

Vienne boasts a Roman past that can be seen in its marvelously preserved ruins. There you can enjoy a guided walking tour around the city. For those wishing to be more active, you can either take a guided bike tour along a portion of the ViaRhôna bike route or a guided hike from the ship to the Monastery at Mount Pipet. Later in the day, discover dynamic Lyon, starting in Fourvière Hill, part of the city’s historic region that is now a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to the 19th-century basilica Notre-Dame de Fourvière. Continue on to the old town of Lyon, followed by a guided walk through the St. Jean district, where you will be introduced to the city’s unique covered walkways, known as “traboules.” If you’re a self-described foodie, our Vieux Lyon tasting tour is for you, during which you’ll have a chance to taste some of Lyon’s local delights. Or get active with a guided bike tour through the city designed with cyclists in mind. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 // MONDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2027
MÂCON, FRANCE

Join a guided tour through the “South Burgundy City” of Mâcon, learning about its local vineyards, museums, historical sites and perhaps its famous son, the poet and minister Alphonse de Lamartine. Or venture somewhat off the beaten path to Cluny, known for its large abbey. Built between the 4th and 12th centuries, Cluny Abbey was formerly the world’s largest church and stands as a captivating example of early Romanesque architecture. Alternatively, explore the architecture and history behind the Royal Monastery of Brou, a Gothic masterpiece dating back to the 16th century. Later in

the day, enjoy a panoramic view from the Sun Deck as you sail to Tournus, or opt for a bike ride from Mâcon to Tournus. Or, enjoy a delicious tasting of the region’s famous white Mâconnais wines. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 // TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2027
TOURNUS, FRANCE

Today you have a choice of a number of excursions as you explore Tournus. Let your knowledgeable guide lead you through Tournus and to its magnificent Benedictine Abbey of Saint Philibert. Or choose instead to visit the moated Château de Cormatin, which dates back to the early 17th century and features ornate apartments as well as a beautifully manicured garden.

As an alternative, venture to the medieval village of Brancion with its preserved gateway, church and market hall. Later in the day, enjoy scenic cruising as you sail toward Chalon-Sur-Saône, or opt for a bike tour if you’re feeling adventurous. (B, L, D)

DAY 10 // WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2027
CHALON-SUR-SAÔNE, FRANCE

Located in southern Burgundy at the heart of the Côte Chalonnaise wine region, Chalon-Sur-Saône whispers the secrets of its medieval past which you will discover on your historic city tour. You’ll also stop at a local market where you can see and taste some of the local fare. Alternatively, choose an excursion in Beaune, a walled town nestled in the heart of Cote d’Or vineyards where you’ll stroll the cobblestone streets and take in such sights as the mosaic-tiled roof of the Hôtel-Dieu de Beaune, founded in the 15th century as a hospital for the less fortunate. Later in the day, treat your palate to a tasting of Chalonnaise wines. (B, L, D)

DAY 11 // THURSDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2027
PORT OF DIJON, FRANCE

Disembark the ship in Dijon and bid farewell to France before preparing for your return flight home. (B)

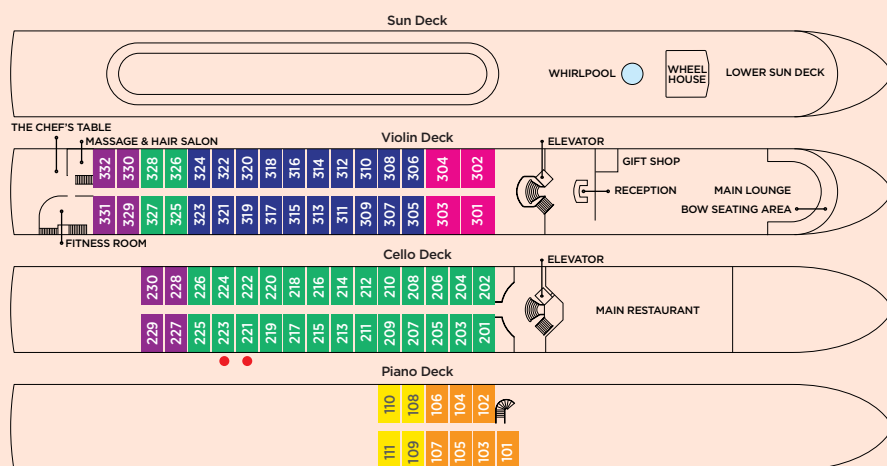

DECK PLANS + CABIN CATEGORIES

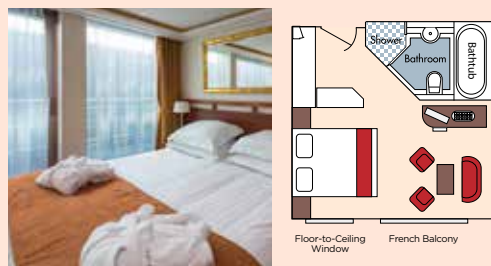

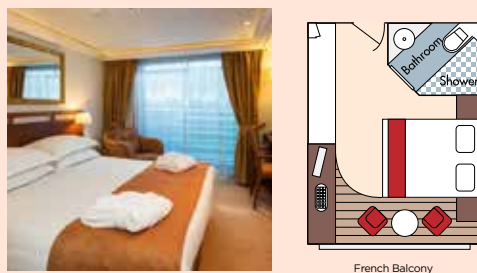

Elevator reaches Main Restaurant, Lobby/Main Lounge and staterooms on Violin and Cello Deck.

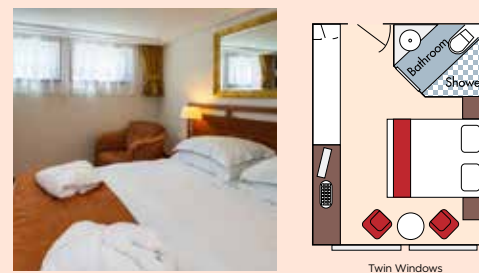
